POSITION SUMMARY

Casual Relief Teachers (CRTs) at Monivae College play a vital role in ensuring continuity of learning for students in the absence of regular teaching staff. CRTs deliver planned lessons,

maintain classroom engagement, and uphold the College's values and expectations. They are responsible for fostering a supportive and inclusive learning environment while effectively managing classroom behaviour.

Key responsibilities include:

- Delivering pre-prepared lesson plans to ensure continuity of learning in the absence of regular teaching staff.
- Maintaining a positive and engaging classroom environment that supports student learning and well-being.
- Managing student behaviour effectively in line with the College's policies and expectations.
- Providing supervision and support during class, recess, lunch, and other assigned duties as required.
- Ensuring student attendance is recorded accurately and reporting any concerns to relevant staff.
- Upholding the College's values and fostering a respectful and inclusive learning space.
- Communicating professionally with students, staff, and leadership to ensure a smooth transition for returning teachers.
- Adapting to various subject areas and year levels as required, demonstrating flexibility and professionalism.
- Following school protocols for student safety, emergency procedures, and risk management.

Casual Relief Teachers at Monivae College are expected to demonstrate strong classroom management skills, adaptability, and a commitment to the College's mission and values. This role requires professionalism, reliability, and a passion for student learning and engagement.
